

Execution Plan

At the beginning of every meeting, someone will be in charge of taking notes. Not minutes or details, but a very clear, actionable 4-column list of "what, when, how important, and who's accountable" for every item you discuss. Everyone gets a copy and has clear marching orders – and they know they'll have to report on them before the next meeting.
